- Ensure compliance with all safety, regulatory and environmental standards.

- Develop and execute facility and above-ground piping integrity inspection programs. Identify and implement operating cost-saving initiatives.

- Establish and maintain relationships with key stakeholders, including contractors, vendors, regulatory agencies, and community representatives.
- Maintain technical reference documentation and engineering drawings.
- Assist with scheduling and coordinating the execution of field work with Operations and Facility Engineering to minimize downtime.
